## Summary of the VWA Board Meeting Held 4<sup>th</sup> February 2009

- AWF President Robert Kabbas and AWF Board Member Phil Maunder attended the meeting as observers.
- It was agreed to cancel Round 1 of the School League due to the short lead time and the fact that one of the major participating schools would be unable to take part. Round 2 of the League now to become Round 1 and organised as a postal event.
- It was agreed that a Master's Sub-Committee be convened and Chaired by Goran Vukojevic with other members to be co-opted as required.
- It was agreed that the VWA would not deliver the Coaching Course previously endorsed by the Board. In its place, a course run by the AWF would take place on a date to be agreed. The Board was informed that the AWF owned the Course and therefore wanted to ensure consistency in delivery across Australia. The fees charged by the AWF would be much higher than previously advertised.
- It was agreed to purchase a new computer to facilitate operations within the VWA office.
- It was reported that the Stadium air conditioning unit required urgent attention due to leaking water in the offices, and that the Ice Machine was not working. It was agreed to action these items.
- It was agreed to seek new naming rights for the Stadium as Mermet no longer sponsored the VWA.
- It was reported that the VicLift had been published, and the web-site was receiving constant updates.
- The VWA Record Keepers report to the end of January was endorsed.
- It was reported that the VWA had been unsuccessful in its application for Tier 1 status with the VIS. Individual scholarship applications will become available in the near future.
- It was agreed that Peter Cayley run the Maribryngong part of the PICSAR project as part of the VicHealth program already funded.
- It was agreed that the following be endorsed as competition entry fees for 2009:-
  - Open age & Master's Competitors - \$15.00
  - Under 20 Competitors - \$10.00
  - Championships fee to be determined
  - Championship fees to be paid in Advance with entry form
