



VWA Victorian Team Uniform Policy

Representing Victoria

Representing Victoria at National Championships and other interstate competitions is an accomplishment of which athletes, team staff and personal coaches ought to be proud.

To represent Victoria with distinction and unity, the VWA requires that athletes, team staff and personal coaches wear the relevant Victorian uniform when representing Victoria, either in a 'team' or 'individual' capacity.

Victorian Suit

When representing Victoria, athletes must wear the VWA issued Victorian weightlifting suit while competing.

Athletes will be presented with a Victorian weightlifting suit prior to competing in their first competition representing Victoria, for the discounted price of \$20. Athletes who have already received a discounted suit will need to purchase any subsequent suits for \$100.

Victorian t-shirt and tracksuit

The Victorian t-shirt and tracksuit are compulsory items of the uniform for athletes representing Victoria.

The Victorian tracksuit must be worn during athlete presentation, prior to the commencement of their session, and to the presentation of awards. If hot weather makes this requirement unreasonable, the Victorian t-shirt is to be worn instead. This decision is at the discretion of the Victorian Team Manager.

Victorian Team Staff

The Victorian Team Staff are an integral part of the Victorian team and are required to wear the Victorian uniform while carrying out their duties. A Victorian t-shirt and tracksuit will be provided, free of charge, to the Team Manager and Coaches selected as the official Victorian Team Staff.



Personal coaches

Personal coaches attending competitions where their athletes are representing Victoria, but are not part of the Victorian Team Staff, are required to wear a Victorian t-shirt or tracksuit top when carrying out their coaching duties in competition.
